## Patient at the Center

**Bob Dannenhoffer** 

Bob Dannenhoffer shared the story of a patient who died in post-operative care after a caesarean section due to blood loss from a loose suture. The event highlights the importance of tracking changes in patient vital signs and staff training.

## Treasurer's Report Jessica Morris

### **2023 PRSP Fee Collection**

 Per ORS 293.231, OPSC is working with the Oregon Department of Revenue to collect outstanding fees.

### 2021-2023 Financial Review

- OPSC has contracted with Moss Adams, set to begin September 2023.
- Financial review results, together with any recommendations to management, will be presented to the board in December 2023.

### **Investment Activity Update**

 August 18, 2023, transfer of \$220,258 from Local Government Investment Pool (LGIP) account to OPSC checking account using established transfer process.

#### Actual Compared to Budget: 2021-23 Biennium

- Total revenue ended the biennium \$17,000 greater than budgeted.
- Total expense including non-cash depreciation expense are \$352,000 favorable to budget.

#### Statement of Financial Position

 OPSC is developing a long-term plan to strategically use the investment reserve to continue supporting OPSC's mission and vision.

## Executive Director's Report

#### **Oregon Agency Expectations: Governor Kotek**

- Supports accountability and transparency across the State of Oregon.
- Performance evaluations for agency directors expected every 2 years.

#### Valerie Harmon

- Bob Dannenhoffer has had an initial conversation with Sherry Lauer, OPSC's HR Business Partner from Department of Administrative Services Chief Human Resources Office.
- Bob Dannenhoffer noted that the Governor's expectations of the OPSC Board is to hire, evaluate, and fire (if needed) the Executive Director and be involved in strategic planning.
- Strategic plans for Oregon agencies are due by June 1, 2024.

## **Strategic Planning Process**

Valerie presented an overview of the required elements and goals for OPSC's upcoming strategic planning session with the OPSC Board and staff on October 20, 2023. The board will be provided with the draft of the progress on the strategic plan at the December 2023 board meeting and determine next steps.

### **EDR Funding Update: Interagency Agreement Status**

 OPSC is working with the Oregon Health Authority on an interagency agreement for 2023-25 EDR funding.
